

Summary of Republican Amendment on Emergency Declarations & Executive Orders

Limited 11 day Extension (sec. 1)

- Allows civil preparedness emergency declaration to expire on April 20, while extending public health emergency to May 1.
- Extends all active executive orders to May 1.

Review and Approval of Executive Orders (sec. 6)

- Requires a committee of legislative leaders, in consultation with the governor, to review all
 active executive orders and report its recommendations for which one to keep. The report must
 be submitted to the full legislature by April 15.
- The full legislature must approve or reject the recommendations by a 2/3 vote no later than April 21.
